A U.N. panel wants developed countries to cut greenhouse gas emissions between 25 and 40 percent below 1990 levels by 2020 to avoid a catastrophic rise in sea levels, harsher storms, droughts and climate disruptions,” as reported in the Post- Standards November 22, 2009 issue.

It is during this conference that leaders will decide on concrete and effective plans for reducing carbon emissions, minimizing the effects of climate change and ultimately creating a better future for our planet.
