Syracuse University Library's Green Initiative Team has created the Green Library Guide, found at <http://researchguides.library.syr.edu/greenlibrary>, to provide information about green initiatives at the library. The library's Green Team was established in fall 2008 to support the University's commitment to sustainability.
