Transportation - Commuting to SU

Commuting via Centro

If you live within a reasonable radius of campus, there's a good chance you can board a Centro bus near your home and then ride right to campus without changing buses. The Centro/SU [Park & Ride](#) program has identified specific bus routes and schedules that will get you to campus conveniently from areas like Camillus, Central Square, Cicero, DeWitt, Fairmount and Liverpool.

To make commuting easier and less expensive, SU's [Fare Deal](#) program makes monthly and 10-ride (weekly) bus passes available at discounted rates. You can even pay for your bus pass with pre-tax dollars by signing up for a payroll deduction.

Carpooling

If you commute a considerable distance to get to campus, carpooling may be your best sustainable option. Carpooling with even a single additional rider takes one car off the roads, saves gas and money, and reduces greenhouse gas emissions. Just complete and submit an SU [Carpool Parking Application](#). Every person in your carpool can save the equivalent of half (or more) of the cost of an SU parking permit; all the cars in your carpool can share a single permit. In addition, if someone in your carpool needs to drive to campus separately, daily parking in Booth garage costs only \$7.00.
